

## Master of Geriatric Health (M.G.H.) Admission Requirements

The M.G.H. utilizes a selective admissions process. In addition to the standard admission requirements, potential students must submit a 3-5 page essay on "Why I selected A.T.Still University's School of Health Management M.G.H. program." For the 2009-2010 academic year, 16 seats are available for this highly selective program; 8 seats will be filled during the Fall 2009 quarter and 8 seats will be filled during the Spring 2010 quarter. The application deadline for the M.G.H. program is 5 weeks prior to the course start date.

Admission to A.T. Still University's School of Health Management M.G.H. program is based on the following criteria:

### 1. Previous Degree Earned:

- Students seeking a Master's degree from the School of Health Management (SHM) must have earned, at a minimum, a Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited university
- Applicants who have graduated from a university outside the United States must provide a degree level equivalency evaluation for admission
  - This evaluation will be paid for by the prospective student

2. Completed admissions application
3. Official transcript from degree granting institution
4. Non-refundable application fee submitted with application
5. Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 2.5 (4.0 scale)
6. Access SHM courses with a PC (Apple, Unix, etc are not supported) regardless of time, place, or location.
7. Access SHM courses with Windows XP or higher operating system regardless of time, place, or location.
8. Access SHM courses with Internet Explorer 6.0 browser or above, regardless of time, place, or location.
9. Microsoft Office Suite (Word, PowerPoint, Access, Excel)
10. Access SHM courses with a high speed internet connection such as DSL or Cable regardless of time, place, or location
11. Adobe Reader (free download from [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com))
12. Completion of SHM 101 - SHM Academic Requirement Course with a score of 80% or higher
13. Essay: "Why I selected A.T.Still University's School of Health Management M.G.H. program"

Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) for applicants when English is a second language. The Computer Based Test (CBT), Internet Based Test (iBT) or the Paper Based Test (PBT) will be accepted.

The following are the minimum required score based on test type:

- CBT - minimum total score of 213
- iBT - minimum total score of 80
- PBT - minimum total score of 550
